Visitor Information Centres 2010 Racking Program

We are pleased to announce the Saanich Peninsula Chamber of Commerce will be operating **three Visitor Information Centres** in 2010. As well as our location on the Pat Bay Highway (2 minutes from the BC ferry terminal) and the location across from the Washington State Ferry terminal we will also be operating the Sidney Visitor Centre on Beacon Avenue next to the Mary Winspear Centre. Last year we spoke with more than 31,000 visitors at the two centres.

Each year we offer a **Racking Program**. One drop-off and one fee entitles you to racking in all three Visitor Information Centres. This provides you with a wonderful opportunity for connecting with 31,000 + potential customers.

We require 500 - 4 X 9 racking cards or brochures which you must deliver to the Beacon Avenue Visitor Centre. Our staff will then ensure they are displayed in all three centres.
